Condemned To Be Modern—the City of Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs (DCA)'s Pacific Standard Time: LA/LA exhibition—opens at DCA's LAMAG (Los Angeles Municipal Art Gallery) with a public reception—free and open to all—on Sept 10 from 2-5 p.m. at LAMAG (Barnsdall Park, 4800 Hollywood Blvd). On view through Jan 28, 2018, the landmark presentation was curated by guest curator Clara Kim and brings together the work of 21 Latin American contemporary artists, who have responded critically to the history of modernist architecture in Latin America. Together, these artists provide a critical framework that connects architecture with political ideologies, social values and contemporary reality, while igniting dialogue about the role of government and public policy on the development, preservation and use of the built environment, now more topical than ever.

Condemned To Be Modern is part of PST: LA/LA, a far-reaching and ambitious exploration of Latin American and Latino art in dialogue with Los Angeles. Pacific Standard Time is an initiative of the Getty and takes place from September 2017 through January 2018 at more than 70 cultural institutions across South California with Bank of America as the presenting sponsor.
