If you weren't able to get tickets to [Jackson Browne's](#) sold-out concert this weekend at the [Grand Annex](#), you still have one more chance to see the singer-songwriter in San Pedro.

Tickets for Browne's benefit concert at the 1,500-seat Warner Grand Theatre go on sale Friday Dec. 15.

The Feb. 9 show is a benefit for the Grand Warner Vision Foundation's youth music education program Meet the Music.

"We are so honored that Jackson Browne will be performing at the [Warner Grand Theatre](#) to raise awareness of Meet the Music, Grand Vision's music education program. This is a dream come true," Liz Schindler Johnson, executive director of the Grand Vision Foundation, said in a statement.

The folk rocker, whose classic songs include “Running on Empty,” “Before the Deluge,” and “The Pretender,” made a name for himself in the 1970s as a visionary songwriter.

He comes to San Pedro with his longtime band mates Bob Glaub (bass), Mauricio Lewak (drums), Alethea Mills (vocals), Chavonne Stewart (vocals), and multi-instrumentalist Greg Leisz.
